Several years ago, Natasha and I were privileged to visit Burgundy, France (Bourgogne), where some of the best wines in the world are made, aged in casks, and bottled by small, family-owned producers. We began each day walking the vineyards with the wine maker and touring the wine cellar to taste wines out of a large French oak wooden cask. We then were invited to the vintner's home for an elaborate feast accompanied by a dozen bottles of their finished unlabeled product. During the one-week excursion in Burgundy, we visited eleven wineries and tasted over 100 bottles of wine. With the assistance of our North Carolina importer who served as our host on this trip, we have arranged to serve some of our favorite Burgundy wines at Wildwood. Indeed, these are among the best wines on the planet.
